

Praying Scripturally for Prodigals

Then said the Lord to me... "You have seen well, for I am alert and active, watching over My word to perform it." Jeremiah 1:12 AMP

Pray for your prodigal
LORD watch over, keep from harm, watch over his/her life; watch's coming and
going both now and forevermore. (From Psalm 121:5-8 NIV)
Lord, fulfill Your purposes for; Your love, LORD, endures forever—do not abandon the works of
Your hands. (From Psalm 138:8 NIV)
Where can go from Your Spirit? Where can flee from Your presence? If he/she goes up to the heavens, You are there; if makes his/her bed in the depths, You are there. If rises on the wings of the dawn, if he/she settles on the far side of the sea, even there your hand will guide, Your right hand will hold him/her fast. (From Psalm 139:7-10 NIV)
Reach down Your hand from on high; deliver and rescue him/her from the mighty waters, from the hands of foreigners whose mouths are full of lies, whose right hands are deceitful. (From Psalm 144:7-8 NIV)
May fear the LORD and hate evil; may he/she hate pride and arrogance, evil behavior and perverse speech. (From Proverbs 8:13 NIV)
Lord, You have engraved on the palms of Your hands (From Isaiah 49:16a NIV)
May be Yours, and You will be 's God; and You will give him/her one heart and one way, that may fear You always, for his/her own good, and for the good of 's children after him/her (From Jeremiah 32:38-39 NASB)
May call unto You and because You will answer him/her and tell him/her great and unsearchable things does not know." (From Jeremiah 33:3 NIV)
Lord, please give an undivided heart and put a new spirit in him/her; remove from his/her heart of stone and give him/her a heart of flesh. Then will follow Your decrees and be careful to keep Your laws will be Yours and You will be his/her God. (From Ezekiel 11:19-20 NIV)

Open's eyes so that he/she may turn from darkness to light and from the dominion of Satan to God, in order that he/she may receive forgiveness of sins and an inheritance among those who have been sanctified by faith in Jesus. (From Acts 26:18 NASB)
May not be ashamed of the gospel, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes. (From Romans 1:16a NASB)
Do this, knowing the time, that it is already the hour for to awaken from sleep; for now's salvation is nearer than when he/she first believed. The night is almost gone, and the day is near. Therefore, let lay aside the deeds of darkness, and put on the armor of light. (From Romans 13:11-12 NASB)
Lord, please create a desire in to come out from among them and be separate. (From 2 Corinthians 6:17 NKJV)
God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may You give to the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of Him. (From Ephesians 1:17 NASB)
