- She has a heart for prayer and is available to be used by the Lord.
- She graciously and lovingly leads her group.
- She follows the Four Steps of Prayer.
- She comes prepared and starts on time.
- She abides by the Moms in Prayer Policies.
- She attends area leaders gatherings.
- She is the representative of Moms in Prayer to her group and to her school.
- She is the connection between the area coordinator, state coordinator and her group.
- She finds another mom to take her place when she can no longer lead the group.
