In this series we have explored the four steps of prayer – praise, confession, thanksgiving and intercession. The video demonstrated how to pray through these four steps together with a friend. In this session, you will practice the discipline of prayer on your own. You can study all three attributes at once or work through one each day.

1. Attribute: God is faithful

Read these scriptures about God’s faithfulness.

Psalms 86:15; Psalm 33:4; Lamentations 3:22-24 and I Corinthians 10:13
