



Girls in Prayer Family Prayer Request Box

Summary—Decorate craft boxes, shoe boxes, or any other container to make a box to collect prayer requests in your home. Make copies of the printable prayer request slip, and encourage your girls to check their boxes regularly and to pray diligently for their families.

Supplies needed (Use your own discretion and creativity, but here are some ideas.)

- Shoe boxes
- Markers
- Sharpies
- Paints
- Stickers
- Glitter (only for the brave of heart)
- Fun decorative tapes
- Pipe cleaners
- Scissors
- Colored Paper
- Glue
- Puff balls



Instructions

Preparations:

- Gather supplies for your group to use. You may want to tell the girls ahead of time to bring a shoebox or any other decorating supplies.
- Print copies of the prayer request slip.

Instructions to your group:
