

GOD IS *our hope*

Praise—Praising God for **who He is**, His attributes, His name or His character.

Attribute: God is Our Hope

Definition: One who is our confidence, trust, expectation or desire.

Scripture(s): Isaiah 40:28-31; Lamentations 3:21-25; Romans 15:4

Confession—Silently confessing your sins to the God who forgives.

If we confess our sins, He is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. 1 John 1:9 (NASB)

Thanksgiving—Thanking God for what He has done.

In everything give thanks; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus. 1 Thessalonians 5:18 (NASB)

Intercession—Coming to God in prayer on behalf of others.

Form groups of two or three. First pray the scripture for each child then pray a Specific Request. Each mom chooses one child.
