

Teachers in Prayer Start a Group

School faculty members have a unique place in the lives of students. What better way to fulfill this responsibility than to spend time in prayer for the students, your fellow teachers and issues that affect the school. Moms in Prayer International provides an easy, biblical format that can be adapted by teachers who pray together.

How to Start a Group

- Ask God for at least one other member of the school faculty to pray with you.
- Choose a place and time that are convenient for you to meet. Many teachers meet before or after school, or even during the lunch period. Praying once per week is optimal.
- Download or view prayer sheets.
- Order a Moms in Prayer Booklet.

Four Steps of Prayer—Praise, Confession (Silent), Thanksgiving, and Intercession

Pray conversationally in agreement, following the Four Steps of Prayer.

During intercession, you can pray for:

Your Students—Pray the scripture verse and a specific request.

Teachers—Pray the scripture verse and a specific request.

Your School—Select one of the following:

Pray for school concerns. Choose from: curriculum, sports, safety and protection on campus, etc. Pray completely through that one topic.

OR

Pray for one grade level or class each week. Concentrate on the needs of teachers, counselors, students, and parental involvement. Select another grade level or class the following week.

If Time Allows:

- Pray that God will bring other teachers/faculty to your group who will be committed to pray.
- Pray that a Moms in Prayer group will begin to pray for your school.
