USA Impact

- 1,067 New USA Moms in Prayer groups
- Over 142,000 combined followers on social media platforms
- 244,483 NEW downloads of the MIP podcast with listeners in 179 countries
- 4,075 women signed up for our online Bible Study, *Petitioning the King*
- USA division and state coordinators held 48 state impact gatherings and 69 *Rise Up & Pray* outreach events

Global Impact

- 150+ countries have Moms in Prayer groups, including first time groups in Central Africa Republic (CAR) and Greenland
- Women trained into new leadership roles in many countries, including first time leadership in Dominica, Lichtenstein, and UAE. And we have our first country coordinator in Colombia!
- The ministry *Booklet* has been translated into 68 languages, including updates printed in Bombara (Mali), Kinyarwanda (Rwanda), Ewe (Ghana), and Korean. The *4 Steps Mini Booklets* were also printed in English, French, and Spanish. English *Booklets* were printed in Kenya, Uganda, and Ghana.
- Global Celebration of Prayer was held in January with prayer sheets in 40 languages

Outreach events and leadership training events were held around the world, resulting in more praying moms and more children and schools covered in prayer.

Here is a taste of what God has done in El Salvador this year, as shared by Country Coordinator Marisol: *"This year we shared the ministry with more than 3,215 people and we trained 245 women in person and virtually. This resulted in 40 new prayer groups formed and 50 more schools covered in prayer."*

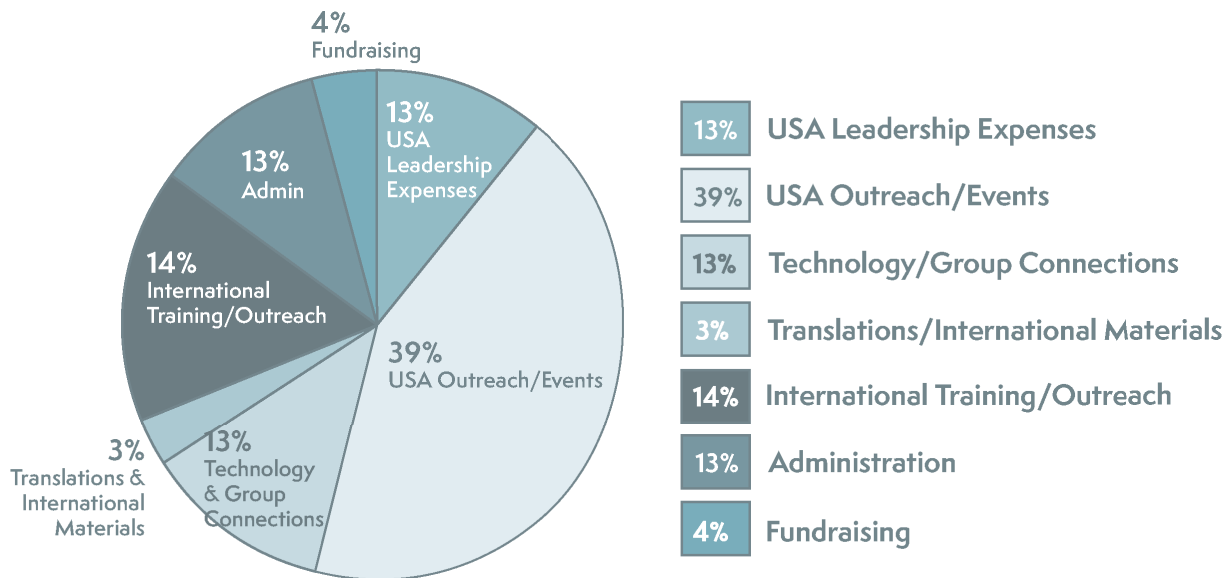
