



Four Steps of Prayer

Praise— Pray for 8-10 minutes

STEP ONE: Praise God for who He is according to his attributes.

Your group leader will select an attribute of God and scripture verses associated with this attribute as a focus for your prayer hour. Group members can take turns reading the verses out loud.

Focusing on the attribute and scripture verses, each member of the group will praise God with short prayers in one accord (conversational, agreement prayer). For example, your group leader has chosen Shepherd as the attribute. She starts in prayer, "God, we praise you that you are the Good Shepherd who takes such good care of us." A group member agrees by praying, "Yes, Lord, You watch over us and guide us." The group continues praying by praising God.

Silent Confession— Pray for 2-3 minutes

STEP TWO: Silently confess your sins to the God who forgives.

Group leader prays, "Holy Spirit, search our hearts and help us to repent of anything that is displeasing to You." Room will be quiet as group members confess silently, from their hearts to God.

Thanksgiving— Pray for 5-8 minutes

STEP THREE: Thank God for what He has done.

Group leader prays, "Father, we thank You for the forgiveness of our sins, and now we want to thank You for answered prayers. I thank You for sending my son a Christian friend at school." A group member agrees by praying, "Thank You Father, that now he and his friend can be strong in You together." Then she prays, "Lord, thank you for my daughter's science teacher who explains the material well." Another group member agrees in prayer, then prays her own thanksgiving.

Intercession— Pray for 30-40 minutes

STEP FOUR: Come to God on behalf of our children, teachers & staff, school concerns, and Moms in Prayer. Form groups of two or three.

Our Children

The group leader will share a scripture verse to pray for the children. For example: May (child's name) be kind to others and tenderhearted, forgiving others as Christ forgave him/her. From Ephesians 4:32.

Cover all prayer thoughts from this verse for a child before going on to the next child. After you have prayed scripturally for each child, pray for a specific need of each child such as salvation, a concern with a teacher, grades, the salvation of friends, communication at home, etc. Pray in one accord for one child at a time.

Teachers

Saved: Pray the same scripture for a teacher as you prayed for your child. Then pray a specific request.

Unsaved: Pray for the teacher's salvation. Then pray a specific request.

School Concerns

May (school name) be guided by biblical values and high moral standards.

May (school name) be protected, watched over, and delivered from all evil.

May students and staff at (school name) anchor their identity in Jesus Christ and His love for them.

Moms in Prayer Concerns

Sustain each current group and add to our number, covering every school worldwide in prayer.

Raise up more coordinators and teams to joyfully share the power of praying together in a group.

May God meet all Moms in Prayer needs according to the riches of his glory in Christ Jesus.
